What's 'In A Name? Ask Him

PHILADELPHIA (AP) — "When somebody calls my name, I don't have any trouble finding out who they mean," says the man who claims he has the longest last name in the United States—666 letters, plus 25 given names.

"I like to be unique," says Hubert B. Wolfeschlagelstein-husenbergerdorff. "I don't like being part of the common herd."

Hubert, 47, a Philadelphian of German descent, doesn't use his full name when signing documents—just the first 35 letters.

That's how he is listed with the John Hancock Mutual Life Insurance Co., which has to process his policy by hand. The company's giant 7074 computer stops dead when it comes to any identification beyond 35 letters.

Hubert's Social Security card has the "shortened" version—the 44 letters, including Hubert B.—even though it takes up two lines.

Hubert said in an interview that the Army used a clipped and Anglicized version of his moniker when he was drafted in 1942. They just wouldn't go for his full name, which he says is:

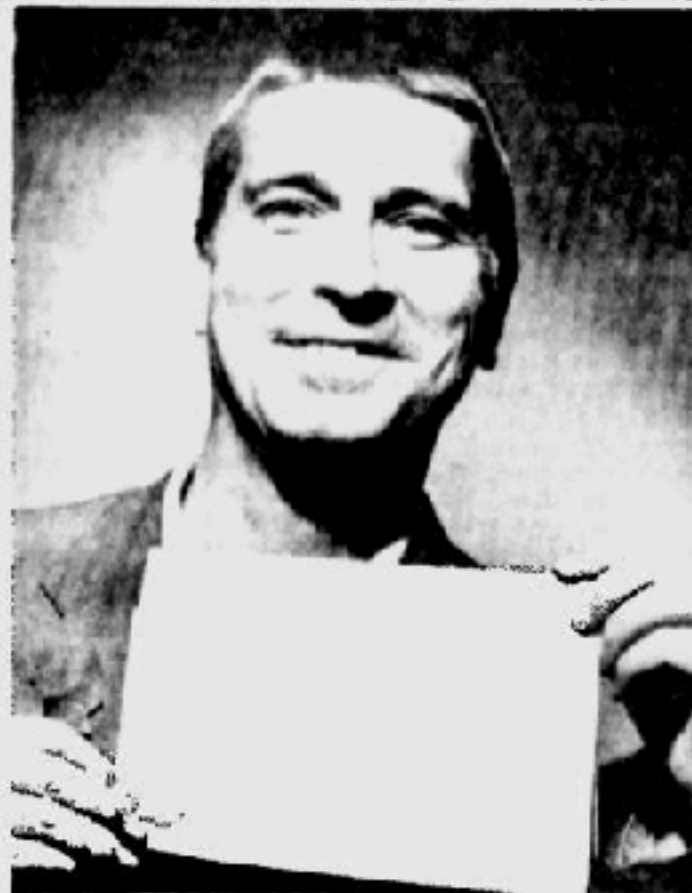

Government Dealt Hoffa Trial Blow

CHICAGO (AP) — The government's fraud and conspiracy case against James R. Hoffa took a nose-dive Wednesday when the presiding judge told the prosecution it has yet to prove there has been any crime.

The blow to the government came after six and a half weeks of prosecution testimony and the introduction of more than 10,000 documents as evidence.

Judge Richard B. Austin of U. S. District Court, who made the statement in court, also said he would direct a verdict of acquittal on 2 of the 28 counts against Hoffa and the seven other defendants.

"There still is no evidence of any misrepresentation by any of the defendants in this lawsuit," the judge said. "Every-

Racial Cases Sent Back To City Court

BIRMINGHAM (AP) — A federal judge today refused to take jurisdiction of cases of Negroes arrested in recent Tuscaloosa demonstrations. He remanded their cases to Tuscaloosa City Court.

U. S. Dist. Judge Clarence W. Allgood ruled that Negro attorneys had failed to prove that federal court has jurisdiction over the cases.

The petition for removal of

the cases, numbering more than 80, was filed here June 11, two days after Negro demonstrators were arrested in a violent showdown with police at a church.

Allgood said that the plaintiffs had not proven that their rights had been denied by any state law or State Constitution.

Rather, he said, "it appears that the allegation refers to the application of the statutes rather

than to the statutes themselves."

Allgood said that the court is convinced that the Negroes will be given fair trials, "and that the removal and trial in state court will not take away some valuable rights which is given these defendants."

He said that Tuscaloosa city attorneys had assured him the Negroes would not be hastily tried.

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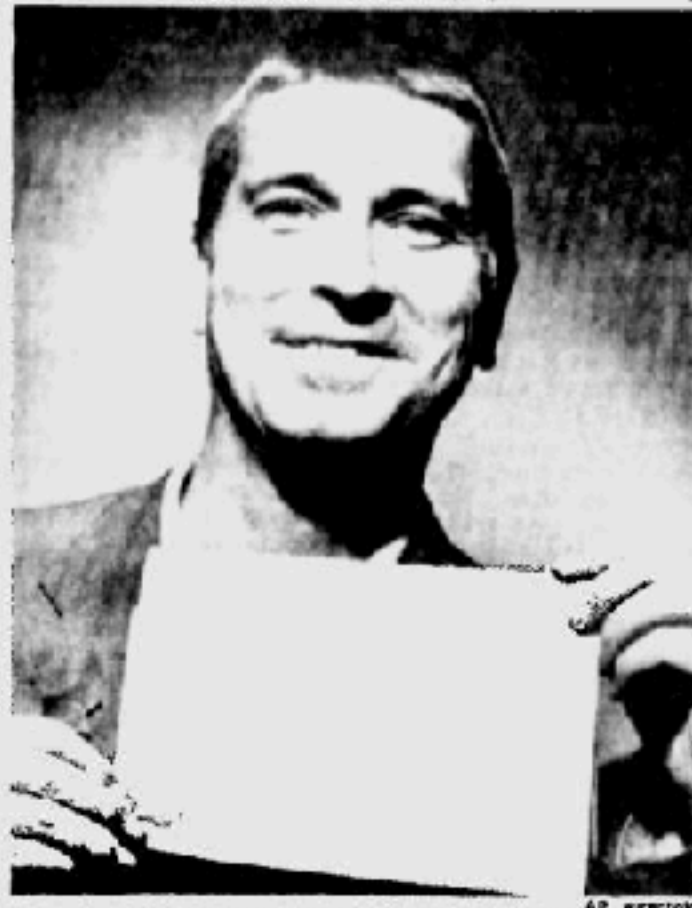
